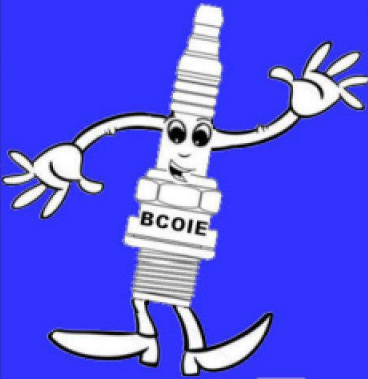

Deadline: The 20th of each month. Bulletin Board Ads: Free to members.

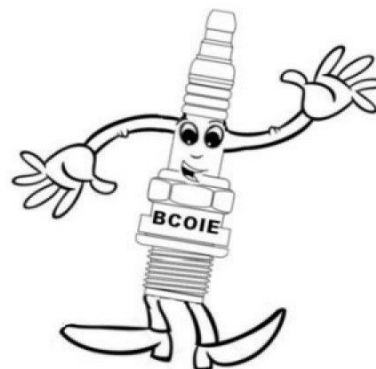

Judges corner

Judging the Vehicles

The Scribes and Division Captain identify themselves to the Entrant before the team starts to judge the car.

Duty of the Scribe:

- Check to make sure the form the Entrant gives is complete: owners name, vehicles year, model, Meet Registration Number, and Division Area. (The Judging form is in the packet received by Entrant)
- The Scribe will ask the Entrant for any UNIQUE features on the vehicle which the judges need to know. This situation is normal with divisions 8 & 9.
- Should the Entrant not have a judging form one will be given to the Entrant. There is a 10 points penalty for not bringing the form provided in the packet.
- The Scribe will ask the Entrant to remain in front until asked to operate the vehicle.
- The Entrant is to remain in front and out of the way of the judges as they judge the car.

If the form is not complete the Entrant will have a 5 points penalty. The judges may wait or judge the next car before returning to the prior car.

The judges will:

- Spend ten minutes on each vehicle to look at the overall vehicle.
- It is **important to be consistent** while judging; (do not judge each vehicle with the same flaws or look of the car)
- The point system will identify the best vehicle.
- The Chief Judge will score the judging form.

Judging for Authenticity

- Judge first in Division 1-7 (Original/Restoration)
- Judging for Authenticity prior to judging for condition eliminates the Entrant from knowing the scores before they have written down.
- The judges while looking for authenticity will deduct items identified.
- The Scribe records the point deducted and the reason for the deduction.

- The Scribe moves away from the Entrant and Division Captain so the judge can advise the Scribe of Conditions deducted without the Entrant hearing the information.
- The scribe will put an official cover over the Condition side of the Judging Form that has been provided for confidentiality in front of the Entrant.
- If no Authenticity notes have been made the Entrant does not see the form.
- While the Division Judges discuss any Authenticity deductions with the Entrant the remaining judges continue to judge "Content".
- The Authenticity side of the Judging Form is confidential once completed of course the Judging Team are allowed to review the Authenticity side of the judge.
- **The Judging Form is now confidential, and NO ONE is allowed to examine the Judging Forms.**

Verification of Authenticity:

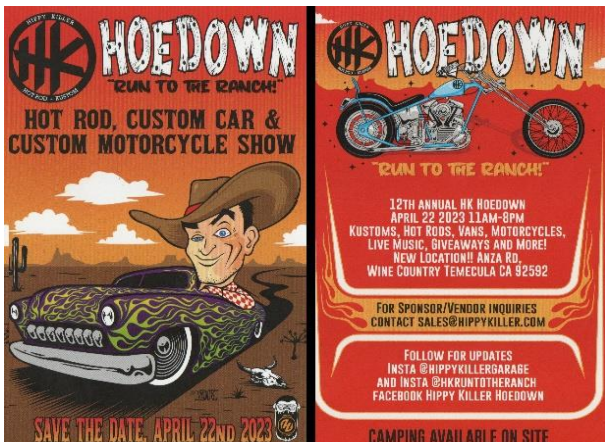
The Entrant will be asked to provide:

- Written document to substantiate the Authenticity item(s) in question.
- Verbal statements such as, "that is the way the vehicle was when I bought it" is not verifiable.
- **Proof of authenticity:**
 1. Copy of the original sales invoice showing that the questioned item is listed.
 2. A copy of the production order
 3. A copy of the Studebaker Chassis Parts Catalog or Studebaker Body Part showing the authenticity
