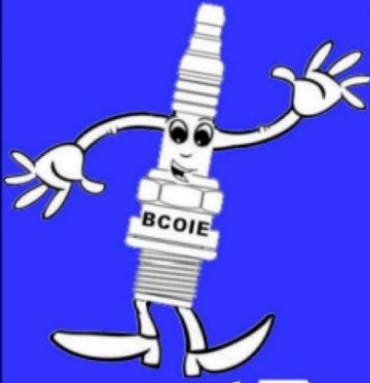

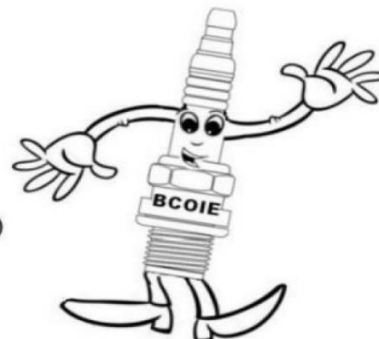

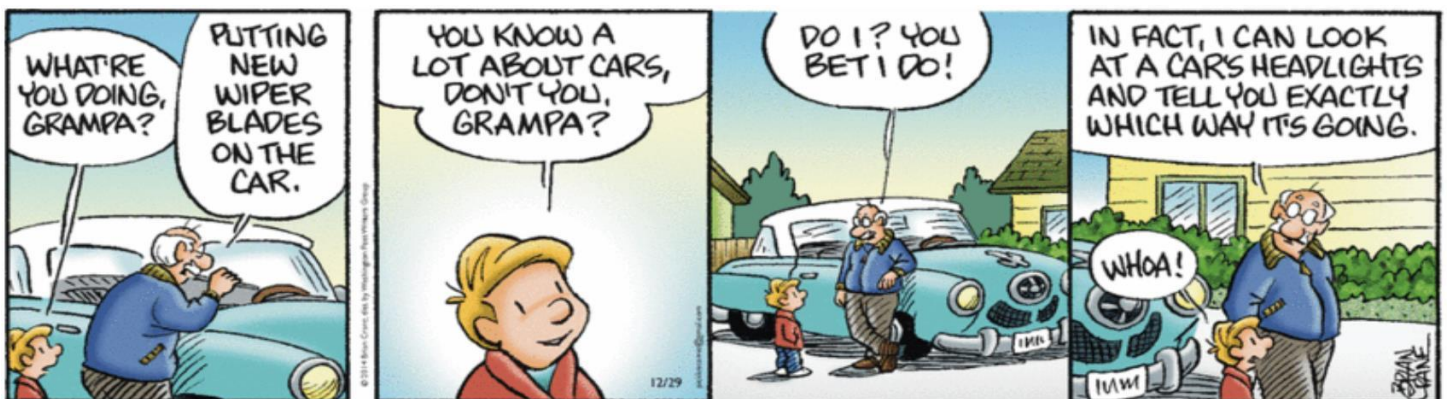


Rosiland: Sunflowers are special because they shine like the sun putting a smile on faces.
