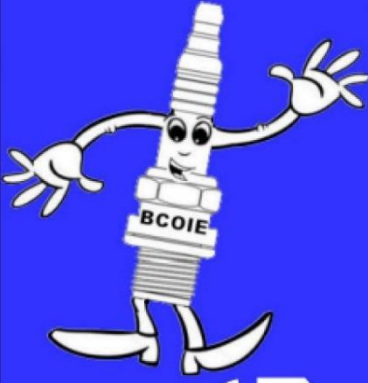

Deadline: The 20th of each month. Bulletin Board Ads: Free to members.

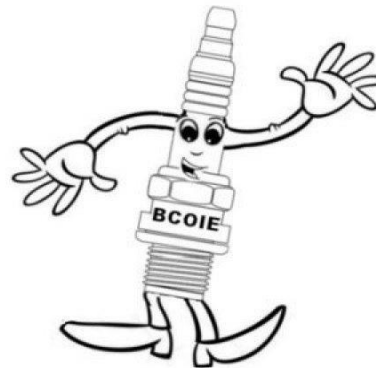

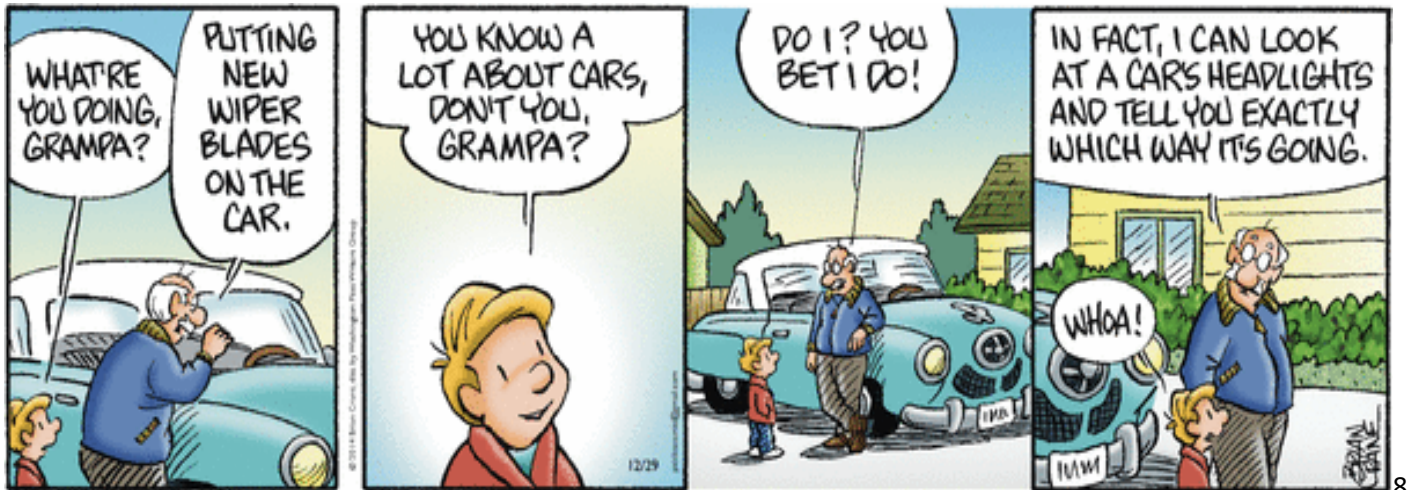
