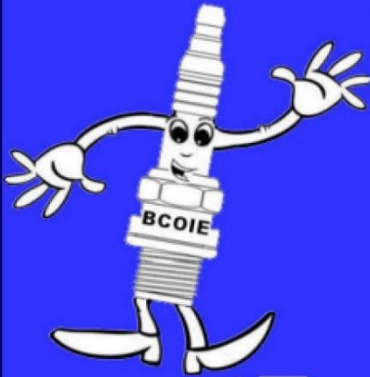

Deadline: The 20th of each month. Bulletin Board Ads: Free to members.

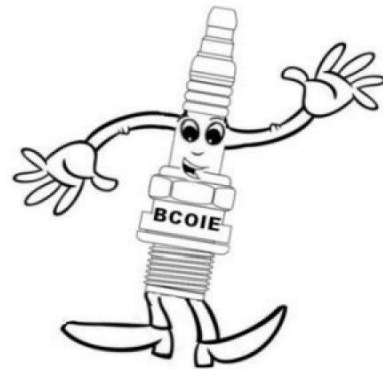

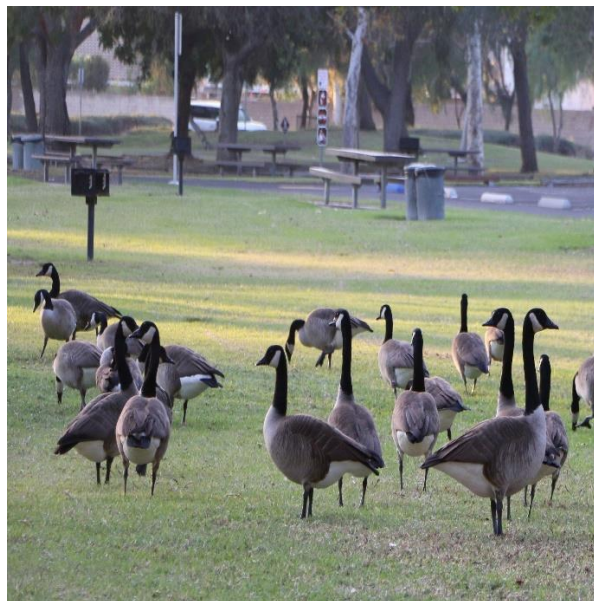
Once you go through the entrance turn to the right driving until you come to Marker for station #6. The parking area has many available areas to park.

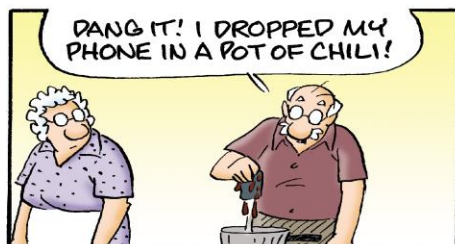

We're being really charitable, giving away the house, when we tell you that in 1963, Studebaker was hugely strapped for capital to fund any sort of meaningful product development. In less than four full model years, it would be out of building cars once and for all. So the industrial designer Brooks Stevens, brought in for a ninth-inning save with the whole franchise on the line, didn't have much in his tank. But his craft for Studebaker did include a remarkable station wagon concept, even if it didn't always work flawlessly.

The Wagonaire predicted the all-activity vehicle a good four decades before anybody had even brainstormed such a sterile description. When Studebaker first introduced it, nobody had a full-luxury pickup with a massive diesel for fly-casting into an ankle-deep stream. Stevens designed this wagon to be produced on the absolute cheap. Even though the Wagonaire's sliding steel roof section was an option limited to that line only, all of its slide-necessitated channel recesses and related hardware were built into every 1963 Studebaker wagon.
